The Local Innovators Institute is a pilot program. Developed to reduce the risk associated with starting a restaurant. Our program is competitive based, with a maximum of five (5) applicants. If accepted into the program, participants will be required to have a minimum of 10 hours in course training as well as manage the food truck with their personal concept with a minimum of 50 operational hours. During the time, they use the food truck, participants will be required to report a weekly Profit & Loss statement and 3% of profits will be paid to Lovington MainStreet. Participants will keep 97% of the profits made during their time in food truck. Profit & Loss Template will be provide. Participants will also have to present their concept.

Deadline to apply February 5th 2021; digital or print copy must be received by 4:00pm. Only completed applications will be accepted. Application process is competitive, and will require 10-minute pitch to a committee on February 11th, 2021, with a 20-minute Q&A. Canidates are solely selected based on their committee presentation. Non-Refundable Application Fee \$50; Please make check payable to Lovington MainStreet. All credit card payments will be subjected to a \$3 fee.
